

# WHAT TO EXPECT

**From auditions to final bows, your child will build confidence, friendships, and skills to last a lifetime.**

## **Auditions**

**Auditions are a great learning tool for theatre. Your child will learn how to prepare for an audition in an encouraging environment. Students will sing from the specified song list (except daytime drama) and do a cold-read during auditions. Every student who auditions will be cast and given their moment to shine during the performance.**

**Please let us know if your child needs special accommodations during auditions, such as help reading for the cold-read section.**

## **Rehearsals**

**A rehearsal schedule will be sent out after auditions. The director will be running scene rehearsals, so your child may not be called to every rehearsal. Each family will submit a conflict form during auditions so the director can work around any scheduling conflicts you may have.**

## **Tech Week/Dress Rehearsals**

**Tech Week is the week of rehearsals before performances. Each student must attend all rehearsals during tech week as well as dress rehearsals to be in the show. Because a theatre production has many moving parts, these are introduced throughout tech week. These include: costumes, set pieces, props, microphones, and lights. Tech week is often the best part of the theatre experience as the cast gets time to bond and the show comes together for the performances.**

## **Performances**

**We will have multiple shows for each production. Performances are held in the Reclaiming Arts Theatre.**
